Statement On Virginia Election Results

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The Alliance for Jobs and Affordable Energy (AJAE) today issued the following statement in response to Virginians electing Bob McDonnell to be the next governor:

"Cap-and-trade was a major issue at every turn in this campaign, and voters overwhelmingly chose the candidate who rejected it," said Brian McCormack, executive director of the Alliance for Jobs and Affordable Energy (AJAE). "The United States Senators who are debating the cap-and-trade legislation should give careful consideration to the message sent by voters in Virginia today and to be echoed across the nation. Cap-and-trade will raise energy prices and eliminate jobs – and voters will reject politicians who support it."
